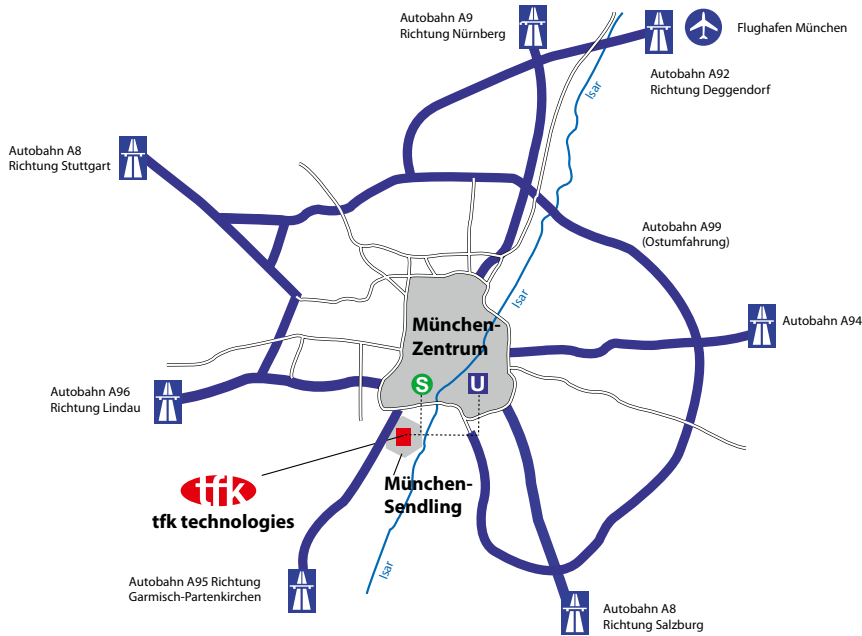


# How to get to tfk

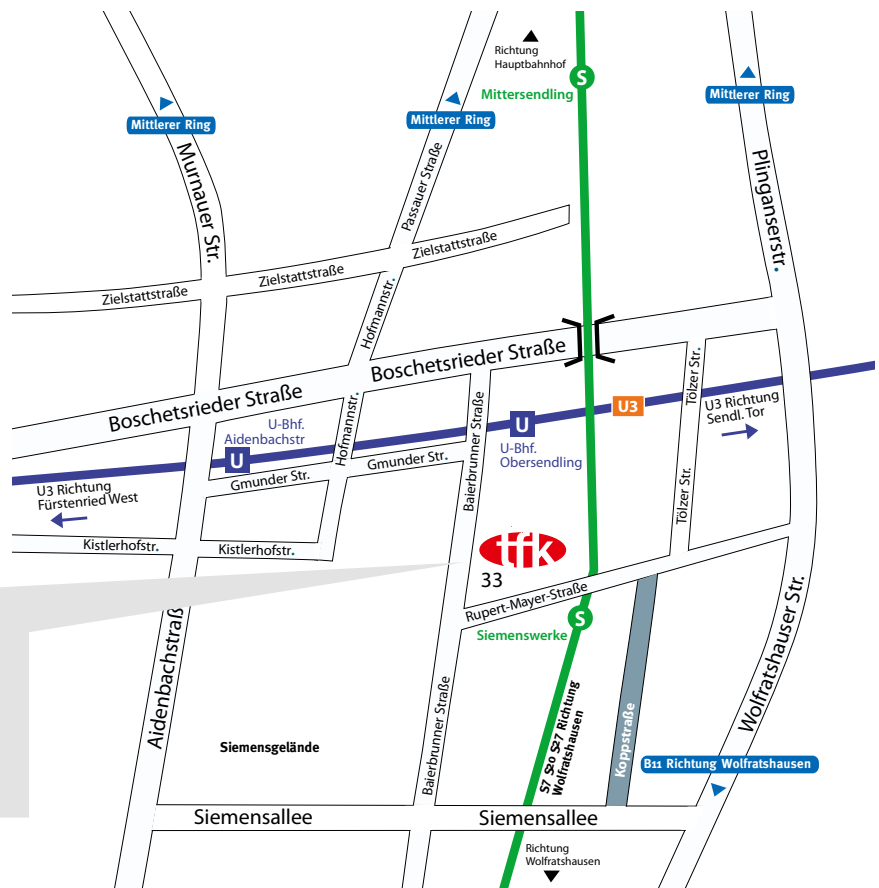
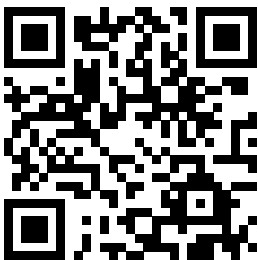

## Detailed plan

Our office is located in the 'Continental Insurance' building in the Baierbrunner Straße number 33.

### Limited Parking spaces

Due to limited parking spaces it is recommended to use the public transport system to get to tfk.

# Directions

## Arriving by public transportation:

### Aircraft

From Munich airport, take the suburban train (S-Bahn) number **S8** oder **S1** to the city center and get off at „**Marienplatz**“. Change here to the underground (U-Bahn). (→see Underground).

### German Railways

From the Munich **Central Station (intermediate floor)** take any suburban train (S-Bahn) in the direction to „**Ostbahnhof**“. Get off after **two stations** at „**Marienplatz**“. Change here to the underground (U-Bahn) (→see Underground).

### Underground

From Munich city centre at „**Marienplatz**“, take the underground line **U3** in the direction to **Fürstenried West**. Get off at the station „**Obersendling**“ and leave the station via the exit „**Baierbrunner Straße**“. At the street turn left and after about 200 m you will arrive at **Baierbrunner Straße 33**.

### Suburban Trains

Take the **Suburban line S7** and get off at „**Siemenswerke**“. There take the exit „**Baierbrunner Straße**“ (at the rear in the **direction of travel**). Turn left into **Rupert-Mayer-Straße** and go to the next junction. Turn right into **Baierbrunner Straße**. After 100m you will see #33 on the right hand side.

## Arriving by car:

### Coming from

**A9 Nürnberg | A92 Deggendorf | A8 Stuttgart | A96 Lindau | A95 Garmisch**

Follow the ring road „**Mittlerer Ring Süd**“ in a counter clockwise direction. After crossing the junction **Luise-Kieselbach-Platz** take the exit **Sendling**. There you turn into **Passauer Straße** and go south. After a short distance the street name changes to **Hofmannstraße** and later crosses the **Boschetsrieder Straße**. At the next junction turn left into **Gmunder Straße**. At the end of this street turn right into **Baierbrunner Straße**. After 200m you will arrive at #33. Our office is inside the ‚Continentale Insurance‘ building on the 1st floor.

### A8 Salzburg | A94 Passau

At the motorway junction **Autobahnkreuz München-Süd** follow the direction **München-Giesing/A95 Garmisch**. This leads onto the ring road „**Mittlerer Ring**“. Follow the ring road and exit at **Sendling**. There turn left into **Passauer Straße** (direction south). After a short distance the street name changes to „**Hofmannstraße**“ and later crosses the **Boschetsrieder Straße**. At the next junction turn left into **Gmunder Straße**. At the end of this street turn right into **Baierbrunner Straße**. After 200m you will arrive at #33. Our office is inside the ‚Continentale Insurance‘ building on the 1st floor.

# Ticket information

## Selection of the right ticket:

### Faires depend on zones:

The public transport system in Munich is **divided into four zones**.

Therefore you have to choose your ticket **depending on the zones** you are traveling through.

### Proceed as follows:

1. Select the **station you are starting** from and the **destination**.
2. Check the **number of zones** you will travel through.
3. Get your ticket:
  - a) the blue **Stripe Ticket** (two stripes per zone) or
  - b) the orange **Single Ticket** (zone 1, 2, 3 or 4)
  - c) a **Single-Day Ticket for the entire network or for the inner district Ticket** (→see Tip!).

| Destination           | Zones | Duration        | Single Ticket | Stripe Ticket      |
|-----------------------|-------|-----------------|---------------|--------------------|
| Airport – tfk         | 4     | approx. 60 min. | 10,00 €       | 9,60 € (8 stripes) |
| Airport – Marienplatz | 4     | approx. 40 min. | 10,00 €       | 9,60 € (8 stripes) |
| Central Station – tfk | 1     | approx. 15 min. | 2,50 €        | 2,40 € (2 stripes) |
| Marienplatz – tfk     | 1     | approx. 18 min. | 2,50 €        | 2,40 € (2 stripes) |

### Tip!

In case you plan on your visiting day at tfk further trips on public transport, it might be good to **purchase a single day ticket for the entire network (= zone 1 - 4) or for the inner district (= zone 1)** instead of a single ticket or stripe ticket.
